Overview:	<p>Hockey Ballarat Incorporated is seeking expressions of interest from appropriately qualified and experienced coach as for the position of Representative Coach. The Representative Coach will provide a vital link between the Committee of Management. The Coaching Coordinator will be expected to have direct responsibility of Ballarat's Men's State League 4 team, as well as provide support to other representative coaches (junior and senior) though out the year.</p> <p>Hockey Ballarat has competed in state league competitions since the late 1980's however has seen a decline in senior rankings from its high of State League 2 in 2001-2002. Hockey Ballarat is located approximately 110 kms north west of the Melbourne CBD and uses Prince of Wales Park (Ballarat) as it's home training and playing venue. The club draws players from Ballarat teams, Ararat, and Maryborough competitions as well as some players who live in Melbourne but work in Ballarat. Initial two year tenure is offered subject to review after the first year.</p>
